








2A 2 Bedroom + Study




2B2 2 Bedroom + Study









2C 2 Bedroom + Study




If aquatic fun is more your scene then you'll be spoiled for choice between windsurfing, sailing, and kiteboarding on the lake, or canoeing and kayaking on the Welland Canal. And just when you thought it couldn't get any better, the 2022 Canada Summer Games taking place in the region will see a \$100 million investment in new sports infrastructure including a state-of-the-art sports facility with ice pads, a para-sport gymnasium, high-performance training facilities, indoor and outdoor tracks, beach volleyball courts and more.



Located on the shores of Lake Ontario, and close to the Niagara Escarpment, St. Catharines is a nature-lover's dream. 90 kilometres of trails carve across the city, connecting more than 400 hectares of parkland where you can walk, jog, hike, cycle, and cross-country ski as the seasons change.







arts & culture

You may have heard of the Shaw Festival, but did you know that it's just one of hundreds of festivals that touch down in the Niagara region every year?



There's the Folk Arts Festival in Montebello
Park; three wine festivals that offer
opportunities to sit back and sip a glass
in winter, summer, and fall; the St.
Catharines Festival of Readers; delicious
Ribfest; and, of course, the Niagara Jazz
Festival. Between the Meridian Centre, the
First Ontario Performing Arts Centre, and
numerous other performance venues,
there's always something on.









When it's time for a break, stop by the bakery, step into a local deli, take a seat at a bistro or cafe, or head to one of the oldest farmers markets in Ontario where you'll find fresh, local meats, fruits, veggies, and baked goods to refuel.




day trips close to home

What's the best part of living in St. Catharines? Access to so many amazing experiences, so close to home. The Niagara region is home to 48 golf courses, 42 nature conservation areas, and countless beaches and waterfronts along Lake Erie and Lake Ontario. Pack a bag and set off to hike the Bruce Trail, Canada's longest footpath, or explore the natural wonder of the Niagara Escarpment, a UNESCO Biosphere Reserve. Ride along 300km of bike trails, many of which connect to the Niagara Wine Route, elevating the standard pit stop to an afternoon sampling Chardonnay, Riesling, and Pinot Noir.




